INSTRUCTIONS

Game format

27 of the 28 DAKER cards are used, each of which contains two values from the dice that make up poker. Using DAKER cards with two values allows players from the very beginning to have better hands and a greater variety of combinations throughout the game.

DAKER DICE:

play dice poker as always,

keeps the essence of hand values

traditional poker)*

DAKER 5 CARDS WITH DISCARD:

similar to Daker Dice,
with 2 betting rounds
using chips with no value.

HAND RANKINGS

INSTRUCTIONS

PRESENTATION OF HANDS:

Before showing your hand to the other players,
place the value you will use from each card
face up in the upper part.

 1 	REPOKER	FIVE OF A KIND 
 2 	POKER	FOUR OF A KIND 
 3 	FULL HOUSE	THREE OF A KIND AND A PAIR 
 4 	THREE OF A KIND	THREE OF A KIND 
 5 	TWO PAIR	TWO PAIR 
 6 	ONE PAIR	TWO OF A KIND

INSTRUCTIONS

Each DAKER card contains two values.
**ONLY ONE OF THEM CAN BE USED
TO MAKE A HAND.**

It is not allowed to use both values
from the same card at the same time.

TIE-BREAKERS

| ★ REPOKER: | the highest Repoker wins. |
| ★ POKER: | compared by the fifth card used. |
| ★ FULL HOUSE: | the highest Full House wins. |
| ★ THREE OF A KIND: | the highest Three of a Kind wins. |
| ★ TWO PAIR: | the combination with the highest pair wins. |
| ★ ONE PAIR: | the highest pair wins. |
| ★ HIGH CARD: | the highest card wins. |

DAKER DICE

INSTRUCTIONS

1 PRESENTATION

- ▶ Social game to enjoy with family and friends.
- ▶ **Number of players:** 2 or more.
- ▶ **Age:** 10 years and up.
- ▶ **Objective:** Get the highest valued hand and win the game.

2 GAME MODES



1 ONE ROUND

Only one round is played.
The player with the best hand wins.

2 CONTINUOUS ROUNDS

Players who win each round are safe.
The rest keep playing new rounds until only two players remain to play the final.

3 MULTIPLE GAMES

The first player to reach the agreed number of games before starting wins.

PLAY IS TAKEN IN TURNS, ONE BY ONE.

In case of a tie, the winner will be determined according to the **TIE-BREAKERS TABLE**.

3 GAMEPLAY



1 DEAL

The player is dealt 5 DAKER cards.

2 DISCARD

The player may discard up to 2 cards or all 5 cards, if they choose, even discarding 2 cards when there is no option for a winning hand.
The various DAKER combinations can surprise even the player and increase the fun.

3 NEW CARDS

The player draws new cards to complete their hand of five cards.

4 PRESENTATION

The player presents their best hand.

5 NEXT TURN

The turn passes to the next player, who follows the same procedure.

4 DURING THE GAME

- ▶ All players can see the cards and follow each participant's hands, making the game more dynamic and interactive.

TIE ON THE WINNING MOVE: The players play a tie-breaker game.

INSTRUCTIONS

1 PRESENTATION



Social game to enjoy with family and friends.



Age: 14 years and up.



Number of cards per player: Three.



Number of community cards: Three.



Betting rounds: Four.



Played with chips with no value.

2 OBJECTIVE



Make the highest valued hand and win the "Pot".

- Card and hand value hierarchy is shown in the Daker Table.
- In the combinations of PAIR, TWO PAIR and THREE OF A KIND, the remaining cards not used to make the hand will not be considered for tie-breaking.
- If two or more players obtain a hand of the same rank, the pot will be split.

Each player's final hand will be determined by the best combination they can make using their three cards (known only to them) and two community cards (mandatory).

3 BETTING ROUNDS



In each hand, the following four betting rounds are played:

- 1 Before revealing the community cards.
- 2 After revealing the first community card.
- 3 After revealing the second community card.
- 4 After revealing the third and final community card.

4 DEAL AND GAMEPLAY



START:

The dealer may place the initial bet on the table as agreed.

(The dealer position moves clockwise, starting each new hand.)

Then, deal the cards as follows:

- 1° Three community cards in the center of the table (face up).
- 2° Three cards to each player, one at a time, which only they will see.

BETTING ROUNDS BEGIN

The first player to act will be the one to the left of the dealer. They cannot fold; they may only call the current bet, raise it, or go all-in.

In the following rounds, play continues with the same player. If they fold, the next player to their left who remains in the hand will act.

5 END OF THE HAND



- The player with the highest valued hand wins.
- If a player bets and no opponent calls, they win the pot without showing their cards.
- In case of a tie between players, the pot will be split.



DAKER POKER: Keeps the essence of poker dice values and hands, incorporating more strategy, making it an ideal game for casual play.

1 PRESENTATION



Social game to enjoy with family and friends.



Age: 14 years and up.



Number of players: 2 to 4.



Number of cards per player: Five.



Betting rounds: Two.



Discard round: One.



Played with chips with no value.

2 OBJECTIVE

Make the highest valued hand and win the "Pot".

3 HAND VALUE HIERARCHY AND COMBINATIONS

- Card and hand value hierarchy is shown in the Daker Table.
- In the combinations of PAIR, TWO PAIR and THREE OF A KIND, the remaining cards not used to make the hand will not be considered for tie-breaking.
- If two or more players make a hand of the same rank, the pot will be split.

4 BETTING ROUNDS

Two betting rounds are played:

- 1ª. When players have their first five cards.
- 2ª. After all players have completed their discard.

Each player's final hand will be determined by the best combination they can make using their five cards, once the discard round is completed.

5 GAMEPLAY

- The dealer (Dealer) is designated before receiving cards. In each hand, the dealer position moves to the next player clockwise.
- All players place on the table the minimum bet agreed upon.
- The dealer deals the cards and gives five cards (face up) to each player, starting with the player to the left (one at a time and in rotation).
- The first betting round begins with the player to the left of the dealer (they may fold, check, raise or go all-in) and continues with all players until the dealer or the last player to raise that no one called contributes the same amount of chips.

DISCARD ROUND:

- It begins with the first player to the left of the dealer who is still in the hand.
- Each player, in turn, may discard between 1 and 2 cards (maximum), or may choose to "stand pat" and not discard any cards.

- The discarded cards are placed face down in the center of the table (so other players cannot see them).
- The dealer then deals new cards from the deck to replace the discarded cards, one at a time and in turn.
- The second (and final) betting round is played after the discard round.
- The player who obtains the highest valued hand wins. If a player bets and no one calls the bet, that player wins the pot and does not have to show their cards.
- In case of a tie between two or more players, the pot will be split.



6 DAKER 5 CARDS WITH DISCARD: Keeps the essence of poker dice values and hands, incorporating more strategy, making it perfect for casual games.
